

Example of how QUEST has used Twitter: #standupSenWarren

In November 2016 there was a measure on the state ballot that would lift the cap on the number of charter schools allowed in the state. QUEST felt very strongly that this would hurt district schools and opportunity for the majority of children in Boston. Leading up to the ballot question, known as "Question 2," we reached out to elected officials to ask them to "Say NO" to lifting the cap.
